

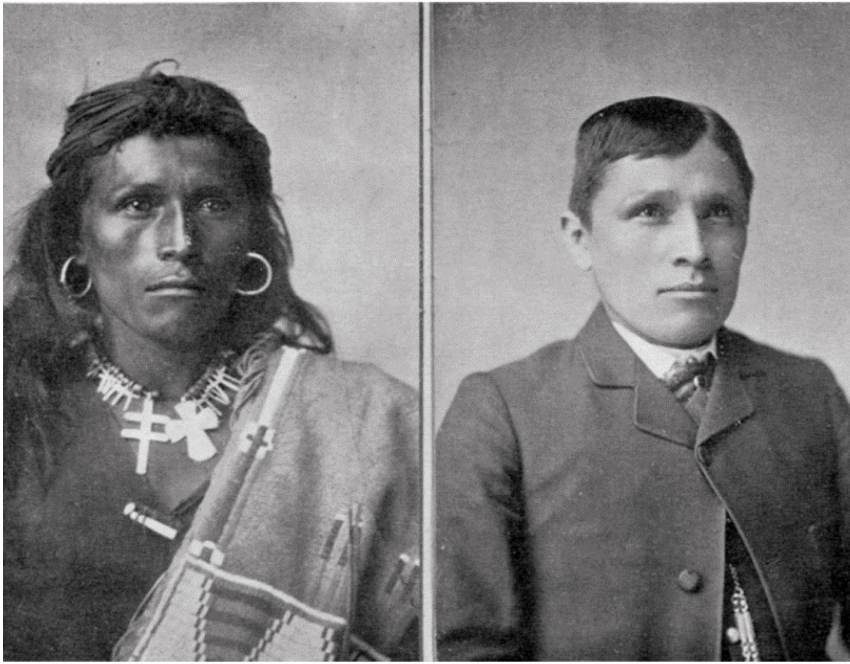

Examines the history, circumstances and present day impact of the American Indian Residential Schools, which were established in the United States from the mid 17th to the early 20th centuries with a primary objective of "civilizing" or assimilating Native American children and youth into Euro-American culture.

Long condemned as a form of cultural genocide, many of these schools were operated by Christian churches of various denominations.
